Located close to the Town Centre of Brandon in Suffolk, the Brandon Day Centre is a purpose-built facility, funded by the local community.

At the Brandon Day Centre, we support older people and those with physical and mental health needs, including those living with dementia, with enjoyable, therapeutic day care within a safe, secure environment. We have a team of professional care staff who are fully trained in care and support provision.

Facilities include a spacious lounge/activity room with dining area, café, hairdressing salon, assisted bathroom and meeting room facilities.

We offer a free door-to-door transport service for those living within an eight-mile radius but for those living further afield, we may be able to offer transport on specific days.

Our day centre members' committee decide how amenity funds are spent, for example, for trips, outside entertainment or new equipment.
